

Hypothesis



Post-larval lobsters (stage IV, V, VI) can live and grow by feeding on organisms that, collectively, comprise the "fouling community."









Results: August 26, 2004 to July 1, 2005



= 91.7% survival





= 74.9% survival





= 31.2% survival

Lobsters doubled their size over a year in petri dishes
