

Analysis of 2001 State of Maine Marine Resource Licenses

Prepared by the Cobscook Bay Resource Center from data provided by the Maine Department of Marine Resources.

One way of comparing Cobscook Bay with the rest of the state is to look at the breakdown of the number of marine resource harvesting licenses issued by the state of Maine in 2001.¹ These licenses reflect biological, social, and market realities that are unique to Cobscook Bay. Towns included in this analysis include the municipalities immediately bordering Cobscook Bay from Lubec to Eastport, and up the St. Croix River to Robbinston and Calais. Whiting was included if fishing effort associated with a particular type of license was likely to occur within Cobscook Bay and not included if likely to be on the outside shore.
